

Wheelers Of Washington Constitution By-Laws

Article 1:

The organization shall be known as Wheelers Of Washington Association.

Article 2: Objectives

The Wheelers Of Washington Association is organized for the purpose of providing organized recreation and public service by users of 4x4 vehicles.

Article 3: Membership and Dues

A. Open to all people and vehicles.

B. All memberships must be approved by the board.

C. Members must be members for 1 year before eligible for an official position.

D. Any member whose conduct or behavior is considered by the Board Of Directors, to be detrimental to the association may be subject to disciplinary action. This action may include, but not be limited, loss of membership in the association.

E. Dues shall be:

\$20.00 per member

\$30.00 per family

\$35.00 for a club plus individual member fees

\$50.00 Associated member

\$250.00 lifetime membership

\$350.00 family lifetime membership

Donations gladly accepted and will be applied to the legal fund

F. Any members whose dues are 60 days in arrears will be removed from the membership roster.

G. Members must be present to vote.

H. Majority rules on a vote. A quorum will be met when a minimum of 10% of the membership is present at the meeting.

Article 4: Meetings

Regular meetings of the members of the Wheelers of Washington Association shall be held monthly. Board Of Director meetings will be held quarterly. Additional meetings of the association or board can be held whenever necessary. We will contact people when meetings will be held via email, internet forum, and phone calls.

Article 5: Officers/Board of Directors

All terms of office will be voted on yearly. Nominations will begin in May and voted in July. The board of directors will create a budget for operating costs, to be approved by the members.

President:

Shall preside over all membership and board of director meetings.

Shall sign checks with the treasurer unless they are members of the same family in which case the vice president shall have the signing authority.

Vice President:

Shall in absence of president, serve in the capacity.

Shall sign checks with treasurer if president is unavailable.

Shall serve as parliamentarian.

Secretary:

Shall keep and preserve all association records and minutes of meetings.

Shall take the roll and handle all the correspondence of association.

Treasurer:

Shall keep accurate and complete records of all funds of the association and collect all dues.

All checks to be written must be approved by the members at an official meeting.

Executive Land Manager:

Shall assist land managers as needed.

Shall be involved with the legislature on state and federal levels.

Shall attend government meetings and give input.

Land Managers:

Shall gain opportunities for all 4 wheelers.

Shall go to all focus meetings.

Shall communicate with the USFS, DNR, and other land management agencies regarding land and trail issues.

Shall organize, manage, and delegate people at work parties sponsored by the association.

Article 6: Rules and Procedures

Unless otherwise specified in the by-laws, Roberts Rules will be used as a guideline.

Article 7: Amendments

These by-laws may be amended by 2/3 majority present at a regular association meeting.

Article 8: Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution, all debts shall be paid, all property returned, and all bank profits, if any, shall be donated to the United 4 Wheel Drive Association.
